1. Call To Order:  
Principal Adele Lindsey called the meeting to order at 7:30AM
2. Distribution of Agenda:  
Principal Adele Lindsey distributed the agenda pursuant to the Open Meetings Act. Moved, seconded and carried that the school council approve the agenda as posted.

4. Recognition of Visitors and New LSC Members:

5. Report of Principal:
  - A. The 2007 Local School Council Election was held prior to the Clubview PTA meeting on Thursday, September 29, 2007. Three new parent representatives were elected.
  - B. The new parent representatives were in attendance and introduced at this mornings meeting. They are:

  - C. As per Chairperson Adele Lindsey's request, Tim Smith, Assistant Principal, was asked and agreed to serve on the Clubview School Council.

6. New Business:
- A. As per Muscogee County School District Board of Education mandate, the local school council chairperson must be a parent representative. Whereas Adele Lindsey, Principal, Clubview Elementary has been the chairperson since the Clubview School Council's inception and Vaughn Bray is a charter member and longest serving parent representative currently serving on the council, he was selected to serve as chairperson for the balance of the school term. Marion Scott has graciously volunteered to serve as secretary for the balance of the school term.
  - B. Advanced Excellence in Education, Worldwide (AdvanceEd), will conduct an onsite visit at Clubview Elementary on October 9<sup>th</sup>. At that time, parents and members of the community will come together for a discussion regarding the educational process at Clubview Elementary. Topics to be discussed include the school and the school district's mission, the current strength and weaknesses of the process, and how to improve the education experience for our children.
  - D. Clubview's School Improvement Plan was distributed and discussed. Clubview will continue to emphasize writing and mathematics as it addresses these two identified studies that need improvement. One additional area of improvement suggested by members of the council was modernization and maintaining the school's web page. It was decided the school administration in conjunction with it's partner-in-education (CRHCS) should administer and maintain a current and accurate web page and that members of the school council and PTA should monitor and offer suggestions to keep the web page vibrant and useful.
  - E. The Muscogee County School District Self-Study was distributed and briefly discussed.
  - F. A copy of Muscogee County School District's Strategic Plan and Goals was distributed. School Council Members were asked to review the five over-arching goals and prioritize issues/concerns/suggestions of each goal. The five goals regard student achievement, growth, human resources, communication/trust, and effective and efficient use of resources.
